This is just a quick newsletter to give you an insight into some of the upcoming activities planned for after Mid Term.

Parents' Yoga

Our final Yoga session will take place on Monday the 7th November at 10 am in the school hall. These sessions are opened to all levels and newcomers are most welcome. Come along and give it a try. Bedtime Reading Club and Toy Library

After the break we are planning to run a Bedtime Reading Club and Toy Library. The reading club will allow parents to borrow a few books on a Monday to read to their child each night at bedtime. You can return these books on the Friday and then borrow more for over the weekend. This club will initially be opened to all parents of children in Junior Infants up to Second Class.

We also will have a Toy Library operating which will be open to children of all ages. We have a variety of educational toys and Board games that may be borrowed / returned on a Monday or Friday.

This scheme will be supervised by Anita our Home School Community Liaison. We will have a trolley either at the school gate or Marian Hall on Mondays and Fridays, so you don't have to stray too far from your car to borrow an item.
