Due to our rising numbers we will have an additional teacher join us in September. As it stands the classes and teachers for next year will be as follows:


Infants: Ms O'Reilly 1st/ 2nd class: Mr. Carr

Internet Safety

On 30th May, guest speaker, Ger Brick, delivered an online workshop on internet safety and cyber bullying. It was a very informative talk and at times quite shocking. He covered a wide range of topics including which apps and games are suitable for children, how to have more control over what material your child accesses online and how to limit the information and data you share online. Ger is sending on some slides from his presentation and I will be sharing these with you all when I have them.

Punctuality

Since the return to school following Covid-19 we have noted that the punctuality of some of our children has been far from ideal. If your child is 10 minutes late each morning, over an entire school year, that adds up to over 6 full school days worth of teaching time missed. Going forward teachers will be monitoring lates closely and keeping a record on the school register as we are obliged to do by the Department of Education.
